SOMA History

With the opening of the <u>San Francisco Museum of Modern Art</u> in 1995, the Yerba Buena Center region of the South of Market has become a hub for museums. Other museums in the area include the Yerba Buena Center for the Arts, the Museum of the African Diaspora, the <u>Cartoon Art Museum</u>, the children's <u>Zeum</u>, and the temporary home of the <u>California Academy of Sciences</u>. The planned sites for the Contemporary Jewish Museum and the Mexican Museum are also in the Yerba Buena area. A major transformation of the neighborhood is planned with the <u>Transbay Terminal</u> Replacement Project, which if funded, is planned to be open by 2012.

Here are the CORRECT links...interesting stuff. **...people shorten the name to SOMA or SoMa, probably in reference to the <u>SoHo</u> neighborhood (South of Houston Street) in Manhattan, New York City, and, in turn, Soho in London, England.**
